Before this activity can be used supervising adults must fully understand what is expected and they must be confident in their ability to supervise as per the instructions given.

Activity Preparation:

a) Clear the course of branches etc that might have fallen off the trees.

Participant Requirement:

- a) This is not a race, take is slow and easy, completion is achievement enough
- b) Listen to instructions that are given

Supervisors Instructions:

- a) Explain what the Burma trail is and what the desired outcome is
- b) Give clear instructions and be in control
- c) Space people at reasonable intervals
- d) Be prepared to assist if needed
- e) Send children who are afraid through first with adults and don't scare.

Activity Shutdown:

- a) Confirm that all participants are accounted for
- b) Pick up any personal items and clothing that might have been left behind

Activity Maintenance:

This activity will be checked prior to use and weekly as part of a weekly clean-up. This will include a general inspection of the activity for ordinary wear and tear or minor repairs. A through and complete maintenance and repair inspection will be carried out every six months and the necessary changes, replacements etc will be undertaken. If there are any deficiencies that put either employees, campers or supervisors in any way at risk, at any time that particular activity will be deactivated until the particular risk is rectified or eliminated.
