*This activity can only be used under the guidance of PSYV staff. Suitability qualified and experienced non camp staff may instruct this activity at the complete discretion of senior PSYV staff. An adult from the group will be required to assist with supervision and control of participants.*

### Activity Preparation

- Preparation will be completed by PSYV staff
- Gear will be checked and logged at the start of this activity.

### Participant Requirement

- Listen and obey instructor
- All long hair must be tied back
- All potentially dangerous jewellery must be removed
- Appropriate clothing and footwear must be worn

### Supervisors Instructions

- Assist the instructor with harnesses
- Supervise participants that are not climbing
- Help with de-rigging once participant has reached the ground (if required)
- High awareness and constant visual supervision required at ALL times

### Activity Shutdown

- Pick up any personal items and clothing that might have been left behind
- Activity shutdown will be completed by PSYV staff
- Log book must be completed

### Activity Maintenance

This activity will be checked prior to use and weekly as part of a weekly clean-up. This will include a general inspection of the activity for ordinary wear and tear or minor repairs. A thorough and complete maintenance and repair inspection will be carried out every six months and the necessary changes, replacements etc will be undertaken. If there are any deficiencies that put either employees, campers or supervisors in any way at risk, at any time that particular activity will be deactivated until the particular risk is rectified or eliminated
