This activity can only be used under the guidance of PSYV staff. Before this activity can be used supervising adults must be trained by camp staff on how to run it safely, they must fully understand what is expected of the supervisor and they must be confident in their ability to supervise as per the instructions given.

Activity Preparation:

- a) Check the slide for any debris
- b) Check for sharp objects under the slide
- c) Turn water on at top of slide
- d) Check tyres are in place and check conditions of tyres, (no wires protruding)

Participant Requirement:

- a) Must not have any open or infected sores
- b) Must not deliberately try to slide into anyone
- c) All potentially dangerous jewellery must be removed
- d) Appropriate clothing must be worn
- e) Listen and obey instructor

Supervisors Instructions:

- a) Only one person at a time on the slide
- b) Make sure they are off the slide before the next rider gets in the slide
- c) Participants may go in pairs once they have gained confidence.
- d) Ensure that the plastic is kept tight and follows the water.
- e) Do not let spectators interfere with or touch the slide or the riders.
- f) Some riders may wish to start from $\frac{1}{2}$ way down instead of the top.

Activity Shutdown:

- a) Turn of the water at the top of the slide
- b) Remove tyres and put away.
- c) Clean off plastic and roll up and put away
- d) Pick up any personal items and clothing that might have been left behind

Activity Maintenance:

This activity will be checked prior to use and weekly as part of weekly clean-up. This will include a general inspection of the activity for ordinary wear and tear or minor repairs. A thorough and complete maintenance and repair inspection will be carried out every six months and the necessary changes, replacements etc. will be undertaken. If there are any deficiencies that put employees, campers or supervisors in any way at risk, at anytime this activity will be deactivated until the particular risk is rectified or eliminated.
